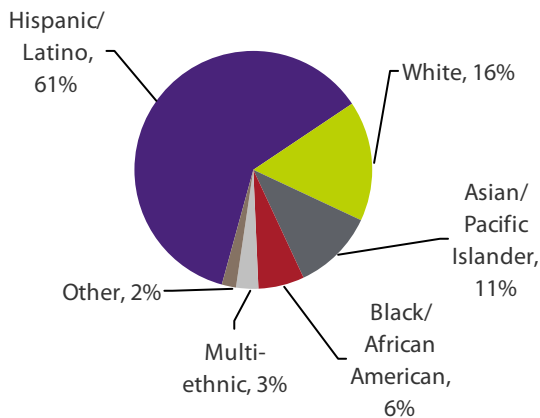
### + Over 45,00 Children, Parents and Providers Received Services in FY 07-08

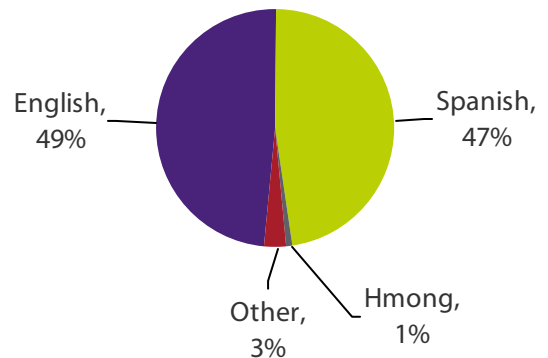
- Approximately 22,000 children, 21,000 parents and 2,500 services providers received a First 5 service in FY 07-08.
- Since 2001, an average of 37,000 children, parents and providers have received services from First 5 San Joaquin every year.

(n=25,105)

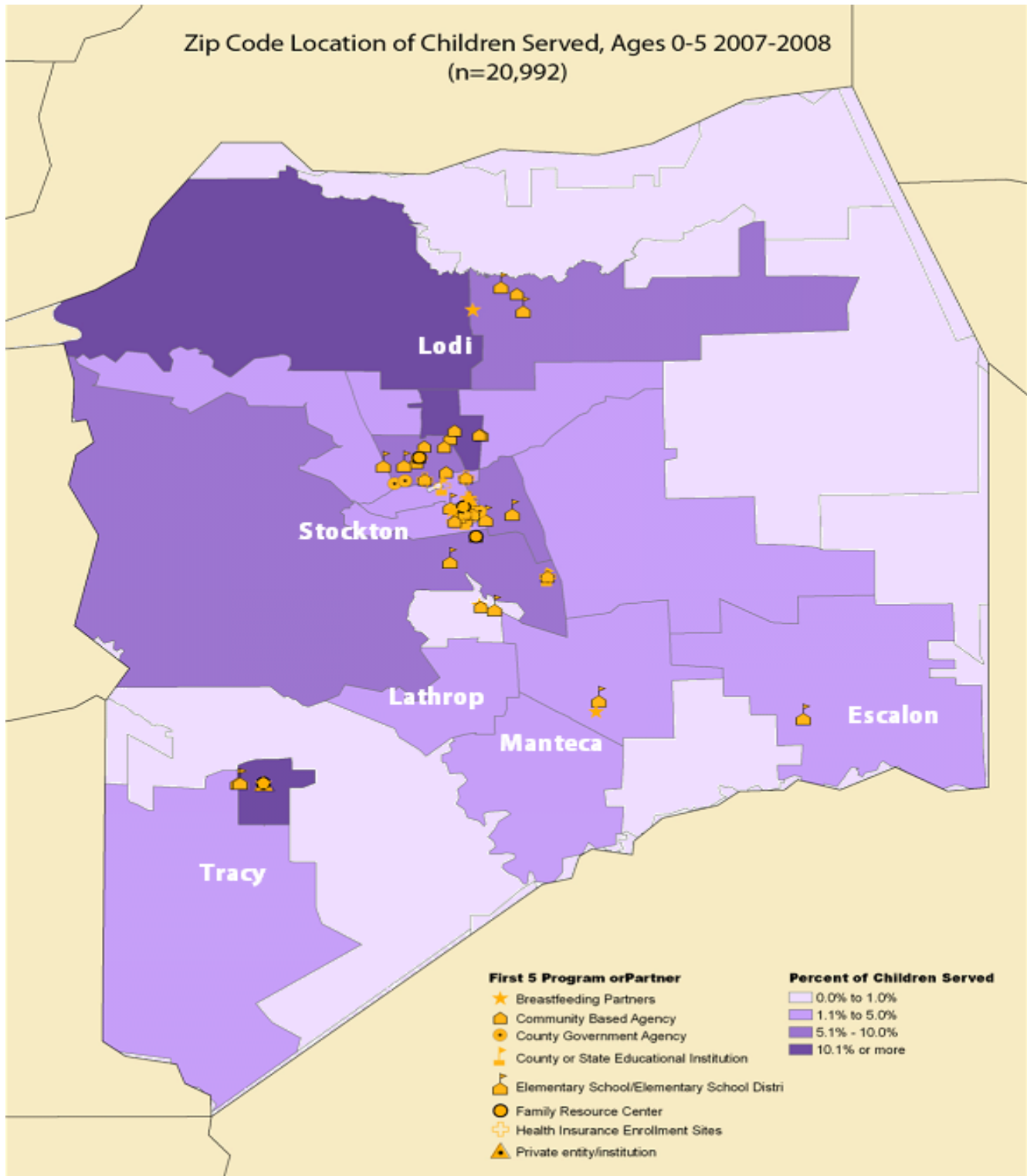


Language, 2007-08

- Most parents and children served by First 5 are Hispanic/Latino, followed by White, Asian/Pacific Islander, Black/African American, and multi-ethnic.
- About half of children speak English as their primary language, about half of children speak Spanish, one percent speak Hmong, and three percent speak another language.

## + First 5 is Reaching Children in All Corners of the County



- The distribution of children served is similar to the distribution of all children ages 0-5 living in the county.
- The highest percentage of children served live in the Lodi zip code 95242, followed by the Stockton zip code 95210, and the Tracy zip code 95376.
