- **Public Health Department, Charles Hughes:** (209) 953-3691. Hosts one-hour car seat safety classes two times per week. They are offered in English every Wednesday at 11:00 A.M. and 1:30 P.M. Two classes are offered in Spanish each month, the first Wednesday of the month at 3:00 P.M. and the second Wednesday of the month at 2:30 P.M. Call Charles for a location of the classes. After attending the class, participants may purchase a convertible car seat for \$25 (an \$85 value). Charles also provides car seat inspection every Thursday from 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. at the Public Health building at 1601 E. Hazelton Avenue in Stockton. Charles is also available to give presentations and to do car seat inspections. Call for more information or to schedule a presentation.
- **California Highway Patrol:** Stockton office: (209) 943-8666. Call to make an appointment for free car seat installation service. Service provided on Tuesdays from 2-5 P.M.
- **Tracy Fire Department:** (209) 831-4000 x1703. Tracy Fire's certified technicians will inspect your car seat. This service is provided at no cost, by appointment only.
- **Manteca Fire Department:** (209) 456-8300, MFD offers free child passenger safety checks. Parents and caregivers are provided proper instruction and education on child restraint systems. During the installation, the car seats are checked through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration for recalls. If you would like to have a car seat inspection, please feel free to contact us at for an appointment.
