- a.) Interest rate is projected at .077 (approximate) of average annual balance.
- b.) Evaluation is based on 3% of sub total obligations excluding Admin from FY 2016 through 2023, unless specifically designated by Commission.
- c.) FY 2019 2020 operating expenses is the budget submitted to County Administration, less recoveries of Coordination Costs for Designated Funded programs, and is based on no more than 15% of the Total Obligations Allowed.
- d.) Minimum reserve balance to be maintained at \$1,500,000.
- e.) To develop fiscal projections, revenue amount reflects updated county commission cigarette and tobacco products tax revenue projections (projections) for fiscal years 2018-2019 through 2022-2023. For 2024-2027, a conservative estimated reduction of three percent per year has been used.
- f.) Source for projected revenue estimates are from the Department of Finance 2018 Birth Projections for California State and Counties 1990 2040 and Department of Finance Tobacco Tax Projections.
- g.) On October 28, 2010, the Commission approved to carry over remaining unspent funds to two years in the future. Example: funds remaining from FY 2016 2017 will be applied to FY 2018 2019. Beginning in FY 2020 2021, the remaining unspent balance of \$800,000 from FY 2018 2019 has been retained until FY 2023 2024 for unforeseen strategic plan needs.
- h.) On May 26, 2016, the Commission approved to carry forward two years, revenues received from CalWORKs for children of CalWORKs families enrolled in First 5 preschools, beginning with Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for the benefit of the Preschool Initiative. Example: funds received for FY 2016-2017 will be used for preschool services in FY 2018-2019. This program is discontinued in FY 2019 2020.

Preschool amounts were adjusted through FY 2020 2021 to allocate the revenue received in FY 2017 2018 and FY 2018 2019 from CalWORKs for children of CalWORKs families enrolled in First 5 preschools. Because it is unknown the amount of each preschool program allotment beyond FY 2019 2020, the total preschool funding available has been included in this document under Non Designated Funding.
